If vouchers are being used, please be aware that the full value of the voucher would need to be spent, as there will be no change available.

Our theme for world book day this year is 'Bedtime Stories', the children are invited to come dressed up as their favourite book character or ready for bed in their pyjamas (this is optional, school uniform is also welcomed) on Thursday 7th March.
